NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by El Dorado Union High School District herein referred to as "EDUHSD" and "District" at the office of El Dorado Union High School District, 4675 Missouri Flat Road, Placerville 95667, until 2:00 p.m. March 30, 2006, for furnishing all labor, material, tax, transportation, equipment and services necessary for each specific trade bid package for Phase III Expansion, all in accordance with the specifications and contract working details and accompanied documents prepared by the Construction Manager, Carter-Kelly, Inc. A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on March 22, 2006 at 3:30 pm at the site, attendance is recommended, but not mandatory.

BID PACKAGES: (001) EARTHWORK/SITE UTILITIES; (002) CONCRETE; (003) THIN BRICK VENEER; (004) WOOD FRAMING; (005) METAL ROOF & WALL PANELS; (006) LATH & PLASTER; (007) DRYWALL; (008) ACOUSTICAL; (009) WOOD FLOORING; (010) PAINTING; (011) PLUMBING; (012) FIRE SPRINKLERS; (013) MECHANICAL; (014) ELECTRICAL; (015) MISCELLANEOUS.

EDUHSD has selected Carter-Kelly, Inc. (hereafter "Construction Manager"), to perform general management and administration of this project. Once awarded, contracts will be assigned by District to Construction Manager, who will be fully responsible for management and administration of the Trade Contracts as set forth in the Contract Documents. All inquiries regarding this project should be directed to Carter-Kelly, Inc. at (530) 621-0950, attention: Jim Carter & Roy Jorgensen, by March 23, 2006.

Each bid must conform to the requirements of the Contract Documents. These documents may be examined at and obtained from the office of Construction Manager, 2808 Mallard Lane, Placerville, California 95667, (530) 621-0950, upon a deposit of \$250 per set (maximum 2 sets) made payable to El Dorado Union School District. Documents may also be examined at your local builder's exchange or plan center. Deposit will be refunded upon return of complete, useable copies within 10 business days after bid opening.

In accordance with the provisions of the California Business and Professions Code Section 7028.15 and Public Contract Code Section 3300, the EDUHSD requires that each bidder possess the correct classification(s) of contractor's license at the time the bid is submitted. Bids must be sealed and accompanied by cashier's check, or bid bond made payable to the El Dorado Union High School District in the sum of not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the trade package base bid. Interested bidders must be appropriately licensed, according to the requirements of each trade package. Labor and Materials Bond and Performance Bond in the sum of 100% of the contract amount, will be required at award of contract.

The bid opening and hand delivery of bids on the day of the bid opening shall take place and be made at El Dorado Union High School District Office, 4675 Missouri Flat Road, Placerville, California 95667 on the date and time set forth above.

Pursuant to Education Code Section 17076.11 El Dorado Union High School District has adopted goals for Disabled Veterans Business Enterprises (DVBE).

The El Dorado Union High School District will be initiating and enforcing a labor compliance program ("LCP") in conformance with Labor Code Sections 1771.5 and 1771.5.

In accordance with subdivision (b) (1) of Section 1771.5 of the Labor Code, the following notice is given: Contractor and any subcontractors are required to review and comply with the provisions of the California Labor Code, Part 7, Chapter 1, beginning with Section 1720, and the regulations of the Department of Industrial Relations implementing those provisions. These statutory and regulatory provisions contain specific requirements concerning the determination and payment of prevailing wages, retention, inspection, and auditing of payroll records, use of apprentices, payment of overtime compensation, securing of workers compensation insurance, and various criminal penalties or fines which may be imposed for violations of the requirements of the chapter. Submission of a bid constitutes Contractor's representation that it has thoroughly reviewed these requirements.

A pre-job conference shall be held with the Contractor and Subcontractors to discuss Federal and State labor law requirements applicable to the Project. A copy of the Labor Compliance Program is available for review at the District Office.

Bids shall be made upon the form provided by the Architect and shall be properly completed with all items filled out; numbers shall be in writing and figures; the signatures of all persons signing shall be in longhand. No bidder may withdraw his/her trade package bid, including bids for Additive/Deductive Alternates, for a period of sixty (60) days after the time set for the opening of bids, and the Board will act to accept or reject bids, as advised by Construction Manager, within that period of time.

The Board of Trustees of EDUSD reserves the right to reject any or all bids and further reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids.
