**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Notice is hereby given that the governing board ("Board") of the Yosemite Community College District ("District") will receive sealed bids for the following project:

**Bid # 10-1627: Columbia College - Site Gas Valves.**

Estimate \$93,500

Sealed Bids will be received until Thursday, 3:00 p.m., July 23, 2009 at the Purchasing Department Office, Yosemite Community College District, 2201 Blue Gum Avenue, CA 95358, at or after which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Any claim by a bidder of error in its bid must be made in compliance with section 5100 et seq. of the Public Contract Code. Any bid that is submitted after this time shall be non-responsive and returned to the bidder.

Scope of work includes the removal and replacement of gas isolation valves including demolition of asphalt paving; trenching; cutting into line; valve boxes; patch back of asphalt; concrete rings and required earthwork for a complete and proper installation.

To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to possess at a minimum the following State of California Contractor License and Certification: A California Class B contractor's license is required to Bid this contract. The Bidder's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Contract.

A bid bond by an admitted California surety insurer on the form provided by the District in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, shall accompany the Bid Form and Proposal, as a guarantee that the Bidder will, within fourteen (14) days after the date of the Notice of Award, enter into a contract with the District for the performance of the services as stipulated in the bid.

The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a 100 % Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if it is awarded the contract for the Work. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Prevailing wage rates are also available from the District or on the Internet at: <<http://www.dir.ca.gov>>. This Project is funded in whole or in part with State bond funds and, therefore, the District and/or its designee will be operating a labor compliance program on this Project pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.7.

A pre-bid conference and site visit will be held on Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, at 10:00 am at the Columbia College – Construction Trailer, 11600 College Avenue, Sonora, California. All participants are required to sign in. The pre-bid conference is expected to take approximately one hour. This conference is recommended for all bidders but is not mandatory.
